

Middle School Supply List

Remember, there is no need to buy these items if you already have some at home

PLEASE LABEL THESE FIRST THREE ITEMS ONLY

1. One jump drive (also called a zip drive or a flash drive) (compatible with Mac 10.1 and Windows) **Must be brought to school and home everyday**. Please find a good way to attach this jump drive to your backpack or binder or wear it each day! This must be labeled.

2. A backpack or a small rolling suitcase

3. Labeled water bottle everyday (NO EXCEPTIONS!)

1 box of Kleenex

2 glue sticks

1 ream white copy paper

1 box of 100 clear plastic sheet protectors (heavyweight)

One metal ruler with both metric and standard measurement

1 pair of scissors

1 binder (2" size) with two packets of college lined loose leaf paper for Math, Science, LA and Humanities

Humanities & Language Arts (please think green & reuse what you can from last year!)

A three-ring, zipper pencil bag that fits in the rings inside the binder

1 small pack of dry erase markers

2 packs of dividers

1 pack of post it notes- regular size

1 small pack of ultrafine black Sharpies

1 pack of highlighters

Science & Math (please think green and reuse what you can!)

A three-ring, zipper pencil bag that fits inside the rings in the binder

1 spiral notebook

1 composition black and white notebook for Science

1 pack of graph paper with holes

1 pack of 5 dividers

1 calculator

1 package of 10 pencils

1 package of colored pencils

1 small pencil sharpener which collects the shavings

Japanese (only get these items if you are taking Japanese)

One-inch Binder

100 5"x3" index cards (blank)

1 pack of 100 loose leaf note paper (wide-ruled)

2 pencils or mechanical pencils with erasers

1 zipper pencil case which can be attached to the binder

French (only get these items if you are taking French)

1 zipper pencil case which can be attached to the binder

1 package of loose-leaf paper (lined and with holes)

HS/College level French-English dictionary (not a student dictionary).

Spanish (only get these items if you are taking Spanish)

1" binder

1 zipper pencil case which can be attached to the binder

3-hole notebook Spanish dictionary that fits in your binder

1 pack of wide ruled notebook paper

3 dividers

Fine Art: These items must be brought in the first day of school for all MS students.

7th Grade: One 8.5X11 artist sketchpad

One 8 pack of black sharpies (not extra fine point)

1 package of #2 pencils (12+)

1 eraser (preferably white) and 1 metal pencil sharpener

8th Art:

One 8.5X11 artist sketchpad

One 8 pack of color sharpies (fine point or extra fine point)

1 package of #2 pencils and 1 eraser (preferably white)

1 metal pencil sharpener

Digital Photography (only for students not taking drama)

Required: Bring your own digital camera **every Friday** with a memory card and your own camera cable to upload pictures. Digital camera (preferably one with a macro setting, self timer, and a flash that can be turned on/off)

Cable to upload photos from the camera to the computer

1 package of digital photography paper

Physical Education (needed for all students for PE class every **Tuesday & Weds.**)

A pair of running shoes suitable for Phys. Ed. (to be left at school unless worn everyday) and outdoor clothing to suit the weather and pants that allow for maximum movement (no sagging pants or skirts without shorts)

Drama /Expedition/Life Skills/Community Service/Moving Images

The school will provide you with everything you need for these classes

All middle school students also need inside shoes or slippers and a healthy lunch, snack and drink. Please include an ice pack for your lunch, if you wish to keep it cold.
